PROTOCOL FOR THE JUROR

The SAA has about eight exhibitions a year, six of which are juried. Our jurors are selected from a group of professionals in the arts.

The SAA provides an honorarium for judging the show. Please provide us with your curriculum vitae (resume) for our files. We also require a **“Juror’s Statement”** to include in the program. A quick turn-around time is appreciated by the program designer and publicity person.

Judging should take place as soon as possible, following the last day of receiving, (usually a Saturday). A Board member will meet you at the gallery to record your selections. The winners will be notified, and the information shared with the local media for publication. Artists who do not have their work accepted for the show will also be contacted.

Artwork will be leaning against the walls with the entry forms hidden, to avoid identification and potential conflict of interest. The number of awards given is at the discretion of the juror. Suggested awards:

The annual student scholarship show is open to high school juniors and seniors from Fairfield County. The SAA tries to display all of the work submitted, if space allows. Exceptions may be made if the work is offensive in nature, is too large for the space, or is not wired and ready-to-hang.
